
What is the Investment Report?

The reports can be accessed directly from the Investment screener from the investment name displayed within the grid table or displayed as a standalone report.




Advanced Interactive Chart

Using the 'Previous' & 'Next' options, scroll through the data tables, where available, to view additional data sets.


3. Interactive navigational options

5. Key Data Sections
